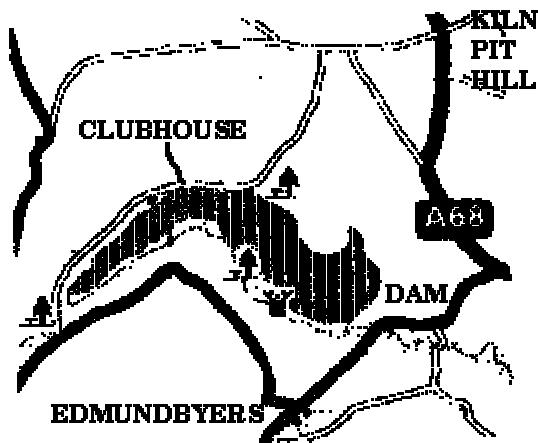

### Directions:



The Clubhouse and grounds are situated on the northern boundary of the Reservoir which is situated some 17 miles west of Newcastle-upon-Tyne and 20 miles north of Durham City and is close to major trunk roads, [A68 \(Darlington - Edinburgh\)](#) [A69 \(Newcastle - Carlisle\)](#).

From south on A68, ignore all signs to Derwent Reservoir until reaching hamlet of Kiln Pit Hill [approx. 4 miles from the County boundary at Allensford] turn left, and then take the 2nd left down towards the reservoir and the clubhouse will become visible.

From the north on the A68, turn right at Kiln Pit Hill and then 2nd left as before.
