Essentially, this means that boats can be left on the beach overnight on Friday & Saturday. However, this is entirely at the owners' discretion and is based upon tide information and a favorable weather forecast.

Once we will have all the results calculated, the prize giving will take place in or around the marquee

Entering

Registration for the event takes place in the clubhouse. This can be on Friday evening and from 9.00am Saturday. We expect a large entry and therefore we would recommend registering as soon as possible.

We hope to have car park tickets for sale on Saturday morning on the country park by the café. If not they are available in the clubhouse. These tickets are weekend tickets and cost £4 which is a saving of around 50%.

Social & catering

- Sandwiches, cakes, snacks, hot & cold drinks etc will be available during the day on Saturday & Sunday.
- A licensed bar will be open on Friday and Saturday evening. The bar will open after sailing and last orders will be 11.30pm
- BBQ. A BBQ will be held on Saturday evening. Purchase tickets for this in the clubhouse. The food on offer is sausages, burger and a beef steak sourced from a reputable local butcher. There will be salad with rice/pasta to accompany this followed by dessert.

Informal Campsite

As in previous years we have permission to run the informal campsite on the Northfield on Country Park. There is a slight change from previous years in that we cannot allow cars to be parked adjacent to or near tents. This is for space and safety. You are to park your car in the adjacent field and purchase a ticket from FSC for £5 for the Saturday and Sunday.

The camp site is basic, portaloos are being delivered for the event. However, the sailing club will be open from 8.30am (ish) and you are welcome to use our facilities.

Site etiquette

We have written some basic rules which we would ask all users to adhere to. This is in the interests of all users, many of who have young children.

It is essential, and fair, that everyone observes the 'quiet zone'! from 11.00pm until 8.00am. If you want to party fair enough.....just do it in an appropriate place. The sailing club bar is open and the local pubs in Filey open long hours, all only 10 minutes walk away. A great time can be had without causing a disturbance to others.

On the campsite, please don't.....

- Swear, or use language likely to upset others
- Leave any litter or rubbish at all
- Play music loudly
- Park in the camping area
- Disturb others
- Break the quiet zone
- Light fires or BBQs of any type

FSC are working very hard with the local town council and borough council who give the permissions that permit the regatta to operate as it does. Your co-operation will ensure that your fellow regatta visitors enjoy the event - and that Filey Sailing Club meets it's obligations to these authorities and keeps the community happy. Arriving & departing the event

Please take care when arriving at and when departing from FSC, whether you are driving up the hill from the club or via the beach. Please be courteous to the general public – especially children. We expect the beach and area generally to be pretty busy especially if the weather is good.

No cars/vehicles can be left on the turning circle and if you are driving across the beach under no circumstances can you stop for any reason at all. This is a restricted zone and access for the Coastguard and Life Boat must be maintained at all times.

General info

The Regatta at Filey is growing from strength to strength. In the last 6 years since I have been a member at Filey the turnout has gradually grown from 120 boats to last year when 175 boats competed. We don't normally have more than perhaps 10 Filey boats competing as our membership run the event – which means that 95% or so of the entry is from traveling boats.

In recent years we have held national championship events for RS300's, RS Vario's, Javelins, Contenders, Musto Performance Skiffs and Streakers. Enquiries are coming in thick and fast for future years, so if your class wants to hold an event at Filey do approach us well in advance.
