National Twelve Dinghies in two separate competitions, on Sunday 12 September 2010

1. Vintage Twelves and “Four-Plank” boats

The winner among the Vintage boats will receive the John Mee Salver and finishing scores for all the boats in the Vintage fleet will count in the Vintage Wing’s Witchcraft Bailer Series and this day’s MAAT Score sheet.

There will be a prize for the first Four-Plank boat.

2. The final racing in the series for the Midland Area Armada Trophy.

This competition is open to all National Twelves including those who are competing in the Vintage and 4-plank Races. Although the latter are sailing different races their results will appear alongside the scores for the MAAT races, i.e. there will be two firsts, two seconds etc.

After the last race of the Midland Area Aggregate Series this day the final result for the Series will be announced and the Armada Trophy will be awarded.

There will be 3 races for each of the two sections, best 2 results to count.

First Warning Signal – Midland Area Aggregate Trophy Boats – 10.55am
Vintage and 4-plank boats – 11.00am

The Entry Fee will be £9.00 per boat
