NOTICE OF RACE

1 RACING RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012.
- 1.2 The Regatta is designated category "C" under RRS.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 Each boat shall be sailed by the same helm nominated on the entry form throughout the series. Substitution of competitors will not be allowed without prior written approval of the race committee
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an Entry Form and sending it, with the required fee to:-

 - Please ensure that entries by post are received no later than 3rd June 2013. After this date please bring a completed entry form and entry fee to registration.

3 ENTRY FEES

- 3.1 Per boat: National 12 £30 Contender £25

Cheques shall be made payable to 'Pevensey Bay Sailing Club Ltd'

4 Parent/Guardian Declarations:

- 4.1 All helms and crews under 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations either by post or at registration.

5 ACCOMMODATION

- 5.1 The club gate will be open from 17:00 hrs Friday 7th June 2013
- 5.2 On-site camping is available Friday and Saturday nights only, on a first-come-first-served basis.

- Please use car parking spaces provided. Vehicles and caravans should not be parked on the field area as this is reserved for camping.
- If you intend to bring a caravan or campervan please notify the club on your registration form, as space may be limited.

5.3 Food will be available, prepared by the club chef, at the club from Friday night through until Sunday.

6 REGISTRATION

Will take place at Pevensey Bay S.C. from 09:00 on Saturday 8th June.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

8 Race Programme

Six races are scheduled.

Saturday 19th May - 3 races

Sunday 20th May - 3 races

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on :-

Saturday 8th June is not before 12:00 and on Sunday 9th June is tba.

9 MEASUREMENTS

Boats and equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with class rules.

10 SCORING

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

- When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- When from four to six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee.

12 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES & LIKENESSES

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

13 Licensing Laws

Please note that PBSC bar staff will refuse to sell alcohol to under 18s and may refuse to sell to persons not belonging to an RYA affiliated club

15 INSURANCE AND LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

- 15.1 Each owner / person in charge is responsible for ensuring that the competitor and boat sailed in this event hold adequate third party insurance to cover a minimum of £2,000,000 for the duration of the event.
- 15.2 Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide whether their boat and its helm and crew are fit to sail in the conditions that they might find. By launching or going afloat competitors confirm their boat is fit for those conditions and that they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event and include the organizing authority, race committee, race officer, safety officer, patrol boat personnel and beach masters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and competitors of their responsibilities.
