### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016*.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20 and the relevant rules of the Class Association.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the National 12 class.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form on the day and paying the entry fee.

3.3 All boats shall be washed and declared killer shrimp free on entry to the site.

#### 4 FEES

4.1 The entry fee is £15.

#### 5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration will be from 9.00am in the clubhouse. Briefing at 10.30am.

5.2 3 races are scheduled to be sailed.

5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 11.00am.

#### 6 MEASUREMENTS

6.1 Boats competing in the event shall have a valid measurement certificate.

#### 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after at the registration desk and may be available on the Club website.

## **8 THE COURSES**

**8.1** The courses to be sailed will use the club marks a plan of which will be available with the sailing instructions.

## **9 SCORING**

**9.1** 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

**9.2** When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **10 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **11 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given to the first 3 boats.

## **12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **13 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 000 000 per event or the equivalent.
