1. Rules

- 1.1. The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the event supplementary sailing instructions.
- 1.2. No National Prescriptions will apply
- 1.3. Competitors should note that Northampton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.
- 1.4. By Entering into this event, you will be a temporary member of Northampton Sailing Club for the duration of the event. You will there for by governed by the club rules and bye laws as publish on our website.

2. Advertising

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. Conditions of Entry

- 3.1. The race is open to any of the above fleets.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter in advance online or at the event for a late fee.

 - National 12s may enter on the National 12 Website. National 12

4. Schedule

- 4.1. The race start times are scheduled to be as follows with the warning signal being 5 minutes prior to the start time.
- 4.2. Launching may commence 30 mins before race start time. Safety cover will be in position when a green flag is flying above the boat house halfway down the sailing club site.
- 4.3. Running order for each race: Scorpions start, then +5min N12s start

4.4. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15:00

5.1. The Event Supplementary sailing instructions will be available on the NSC website and at the time of registration on the Office noticeboard. No additional copies will be provided.

6.1. Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

7. Insurance

7.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid Third-Party Liability Insurance with a Minimum Cover of £3 million.

NOTICE TO ALL VISITORS - Invasive Species Procedure.

Before launching, all competitors are required to ensure that their boat has been 'Checked, Cleaned and Dried' for a minimum of two days prior to arriving at Northampton Sailing Club. Before you leave you will also be required to ensure you use one of the designated wash down stations before going to another location.
